By participating in **Trike-A-Thon**, your child will learn these four riding-toy safety rules:

1 Always wear your helmet.



2 Never ride in the street.

3 Always be careful near driveways.



4 Always watch where you're going.

What is Trike-A-Thon?

Trike-A-Thon is a fun, week-long curriculum that teaches your child riding-toy safety. Your child will learn a different lesson each day with special St. Jude friends Bikewell Bear® and Pedals the Bunny® in colorfully illustrated adventures and take-home coloring sheets. At the end of the week, students bring their trikes or riding-toys to school and practice the rules they've learned at the **Trike-A-Thon**.

How do you participate?

Step 1 – Sign up. Fill out the Parent or Guardian Permission/Consent form attached to this envelope and return it to your child's daycare center/pre-school within one week.

Step 2 – Set your goal. Check out the prizes at www.stjude.org/trike to see what your child and their daycare center/pre-school can earn. (Each child will receive a coloring book and stickers for participating.)

Step 3 – Get Sponsors. Find people who will pledge \$1 or more per lap. (Most children complete 25 laps in a half-hour period.) Or ask them to donate \$10, \$20 or more to St. Jude.

Step 4 – Read each safety lesson to your child to reinforce the safety lesson of the day.

Step 5 – Collect pledges. Be sure to turn in donations to your child's school within 7 days of completing the **Trike-A-Thon**. Ask sponsors to make tax-deductible checks payable to **St. Jude Children's Research Hospital**. (Please write a check or obtain a money order for any cash you receive.)

Consent to participation and waiver, release and indemnity agreement

The undersigned individual for himself/herself and his/her children or ward(s) (collectively and individually referred to as the "Undersigned"), in consideration of allowing the Undersigned to participate in the Trike activity that may include participation through internet based, online activities (referred to as the "Event") for the benefit of St. Jude Children's Research Hospital, Inc., ("St. Jude"), the Undersigned hereby consent(s) to the participation in the Event and voluntarily agree(s) not to bring suit, to forever release, to hold harmless, indemnify and defend St. Jude, American Lebanese Syrian Associated Charities, Inc., ("ALSAC"), the Municipalities, Counties, or other local governments in or through which the Event may take place or is conducted, and any other person, entity or sponsor connected with the Event, their respective directors, agents, employees (collectively the "Released Parties"), from all claims, actions and liabilities of any type (including, but not limited to, damages for personal injury or death) that the Undersigned, at any time, may have that in any way arise out of the Event, including any negligent act or failure to act by the Released Parties.
